## **Public meeting for former Nike Missile Site CL-59 to be held Aug. 24**

PARMA, Ohio — The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) will be holding a public meeting to discuss the proposed plan for the former Nike Missile Site CL-59, a formerly used defense site located in Parma Heights, Ohio, Tuesday, Aug. 24 at the Cuyahoga Community College, Western Campus, 11000 Pleasant Valley Road, Parma, in the Galleria, Room G04A-B at 7 p.m.

The environmental investigation at the former Nike Missile Site CL-59 is complete, and as a result, USACE, in compliance with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), are proposing that No Further Action is warranted at the site.

“The environmental investigation has determined that the site does not pose an unacceptable risk to the community or the environment,” said USACE Louisville District project manager Carla Heck. “This public meeting will give the community an opportunity to ask questions about the investigation and participate in the final decision-making process.”

USACE has been soliciting public comments on the proposal since Aug. 6 and is accepting comments until Sept. 4. Public comments received during this period will be considered in the final decision-making process for the former Nike Missile Site C-72. Comments should be sent to Dr. Dave Brancato, P.O.
