Notice to the Public

Scioto Ordnance Plant

Starting Friday, May 3, 2013 and continuing for the next six to eight Fridays, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Louisville District - through their contractors Environmental Quality Management, Inc. and USA Environmental - will be destroying munitions debris at the former Scioto Ordnance Plant.

The work will be completed at a location northeast of the intersection of Pole Lane and Likens roads on private property.

Access to the site is restricted to the public. An unexploded ordnance (UXO) safety officer is on-site overseeing the activity and the local fire and sheriff's departments and county airport have been notified.

The work will be conducted between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

The public should anticipate the following in the vicinity of the site: explosion noise, dust and some vibrations. The site is being monitored for vibrations to prevent any property damage.
