Proposed Plan for Victory Ordnance Plant

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers invites you to review and comment on the proposed plan of No Further Action (NFA) at Victory Ordnance Plant (VOP) Battery Disposal Area (BDA) a Formerly Used Defense Site (FUDS) in Decatur, Illinois.

The Battery Disposal Area which is approximately 3.7 acres, is a former Department of Defense (DoD)-related disposal pit located in the installation. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has recently completed a study of the BDA to evaluate the nature and extent of potential contamination.

No Further Action at the site has been recommended and is presented in the proposed plan. Copies of the proposed plan are available for public review in the Administrative Record housed at the Decatur Public Library located at 130 N. Franklin St., Decatur, IL, 62523.
