


# FY-12 Accomplishments

- **Contracting** – 3883 actions totaling over **\$1.15B in obligations**
- **Civil Works** – **\$193.5M in obligations**: regular, supplemental, ARRA
- **Military Programs** – Awarded 48 projects totaling over **\$1.01B**
- **Environmental** – Executed over **\$56.3M** in support of DOD and non-DOD programs, including:
  - \$10.1M Environmental Quality
  - \$13.9M Defense Environmental Restoration Program (DERP)
  - \$ 4.4M BRAC
  - \$27.9M Formerly Used Defense Sites Program (FUDS)
- **Small Business** – **Awarded \$499.7M to SMALL BUSINESSES**




