**D. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO SUPPORT JD:** UNT 1 and UNT 3 are defined tributaries with OHWM and intermittent flow that have historically been manipulated (straightened) to accommodate agriculture and highway construction. UNT 8 and contiguous Wetlands 23 and 27 were channelized and relocated during the construction of US 231 (the original channel location appears in recent aeriels and topo maps). All of the remaining resources included in this Determination are ditches created in dry land with ephemeral flow that are not relocated tributaries. The identified emergent wetlands are contained wholly within the the ditches.
