No. LRL-2010-323.

PURPOSE: To provide aquatic habitat enhancement,
rehabilitation, re-establishment, preservation
and buffer enhancement activities.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The Elm Fork Stream Restoration Project would enhance, rehabilitate, and re-establish approximately 4,500 linear feet of Elm Fork, a perennial stream, approximately 2,100 linear feet of Minors Creek, a perennial stream and approximately 1,900 linear feet of unnamed intermittent and ephemeral tributaries to these streams. The project would also include riparian buffer restoration and would result in an estimated net gain of 12,000 Adjusted Mitigation Units. The project would be permanently protected.
