

WELCOME TO  
**LITTCARR CAMPGROUND**

All Corps of Engineers' project lands and waters are protected under Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations. Copies of Title 36 are available from the Park Attendant or a Park Ranger and are also posted on bulletin boards. So that all campers may enjoy their stay in this campground, we ask that the following rules/regulations be observed.

All campers and visitors are required to register with the Park Attendant. They must also stop every time they pass the entrance station and display a vehicle camper/visitor pass.

Camping is permitted only at designated campsites. Site occupancy is limited to six (6) people per night and two (2) vehicles per site. Equipment is limited to one primary and one secondary unit, such as one trailer or motorhome and one small tent. Camping is limited to fourteen (14) consecutive days in any thirty (30) day period.

Please observe the 15 mph speed limit and traffic regulations. All wheeled vehicles should be parked in designated parking areas. Parking on the grass is prohibited except for boat trailers. Vehicles should be used for entering and exiting the campground only – repeatedly “circling” or “cruising” the campground is prohibited. All terrain vehicle (ATV) and/or off-road vehicle (ORV) operation is prohibited. Bicycles are allowed only between campsites 1 and 19 – not by campsites 20 through 28 nor on the hill by the water treatment plant. Riding bicycles is not permitted after dark.

Parents are responsible for their children at all times. Children should be supervised while using playground equipment and kept away from the playground area during quiet hours. All pets must be penned, caged or on a leash and properly cleaned after.

All guests of registered campers (including walk-in visitors) are required to pay a visitor's fee of \$1 per person or a maximum of \$3 per vehicle. Visitors are required to park outside the campground if two (2) vehicles are already on the campsite. All visitors must leave the campground before 9:30 p.m.

Quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. daily. Excessive noise during this period is prohibited.

Local law prohibits alcoholic beverages throughout the project area.

All firearms, ammunition, weapons or explosives, including fireworks, are prohibited.

Fires are permitted only in provided fire rings.

Horseshoe pits are located behind campsites 16 and 17. Please refrain from playing horseshoes out of the designated area. Horseshoes are available for check-out from the Park Attendants.

Picnic shelters that are reserved are not available to other users.

Check out time is 3:00 p.m. - earlier notice would be appreciated.

Please put all trash in the dumpster, which is easily accessed as you exit the campground. Plastic bags are available on request.
