

22nd Annual Green River Lake Lakeshore Cleanup

Thanks to the hard work of 301 volunteers and the support of 84 sponsors, the 22nd Annual Green River Lake Lakeshore Cleanup was another huge success.

On Saturday, September 20, 2008 approximately 217 bags of trash, 22 tires, 2 mattresses and 1 gas tank was picked up from the lakeshore with a cost savings to the government of over \$17,617.53. Volunteers at the event consisted of students from Lindsay-Wilson and Campbellsville College, the Lindsay-Wilson basketball team, Taylor County FFA, girl scouts, boy scouts, cub scouts, church groups and community members that all worked along side one another for the common goal of a cleaner environment and enhancing the aesthetic appeal of Green River Lake. After the cleanup, everyone that participated in the cleanup was treated to a free lunch and prize giveaway generously provided by local businesses with approximately \$1,365 worth of food items and \$3,257 worth of prizes donated.
