FUDS – Property Transfer Documents - LRD Program

- Supplement Guidance to FUDS ER (05 Sep 07)
 - Requires FUDS districts to identify/evaluate transfer documents

- Lakes and Rivers Division (LRD)
 - 417 FUDS Properties
 - Only 32 properties under an Archive Search Record (ASR) contract

- 4 Types of Property Status & Priority
 - 1. Underway
 - 2. Pending
 - 3. Future
 - 4. Completed

FUDS – Archive Search Records (ASR) Contract

- Initial records search of 32 properties
 - Documents chronological ownership
 - Identify & Evaluate clauses in transfer documents
 - Documents historical use

- Used to determine legal property status

- ASR includes, but not limited to:
 - Legal and Property Documentation
 - Property transfer laws and regulations
 - Title Transfer Records
 - Merger/Acquisition documentation
 - Financial Viability Report



Grow the Army

- Active Army – gain ~ 65,000 soldiers
 - Ft. Campbell/Ft. Knox – minimal plus-up

- Army Reserve – gain ~ 1,000 soldiers
 - Approximately 36 sites identified for Environmental support
 - Work to begin Spring 2008
 - To be completed in Fall 2012

BRAC 05 ECP – Phase II on USAR sites

■ Current Status

- Phase I completed
- IMCOM recommends LRL as executing district for Phase II
- Awaiting concurrence and funding from BRAC-D

■ Phase II includes, but not limited to:

- Data gap analysis (PER, PA, ASR, FOIA, etc.)
- Intrusive investigations (SI, RI, etc.)
- Remedial Actions (RD, RA, RAO, LTM, etc.)

Regulatory Boundary Proposal

Release date: Dec. 5, 2005

Cincinnati – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is seeking public comments about its proposal to realign responsibilities for managing the Corps' regulatory program pursuant to Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (33 U.S.C. 403) and Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1344) in Ohio and Kentucky.

Under the proposal, the Huntington District will be responsible for the regulatory program in Southern Ohio and the Louisville District for all of Eastern Kentucky.

The proposal is meant to help eliminate confusion by the public as to which district to submit requests for permits. Currently, the Eastern portion of Kentucky is split between two Corps districts, Louisville and Huntington. The Southern portion of Ohio is also split between Huntington and Louisville.




