BANK STABILIZATION AND PROTECTION

OHIO RIVER MILE 607.0 TO 608.0

1. Notice is given that on or about 20 October 2008 , the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers contractor MAC Construction will begin repairs to a 350 foot section of the right descending bank between Ohio River Mile 608 and 608.
2. The contractor will be working from the land to place stone to stabilize and protect the bank. Work is expected to take two weeks from onset.
3. While this work occurs outside the navigation channel, this area should not be used while waiting for lockage through McAlpine locks. Once the protection is completed mariners should use caution pushing into the bank in this area.
