Schedule announced for Corps campground openings in '08

LOUISVILLE, Ky. — It's not too early to begin making plans for spring or summer recreational visits to U.S. Army Corps of Engineers operated facilities.

Reservations may be booked in advance through the National Recreation Reservation Service (NRRS™) by calling 1-877-444-6777 (TDD 1-877-833-6777) or online at www.recreation.gov. Advance reservations may be booked up to six months from the date of check-in. Restrictions do apply and some services have changed as of October 2007. Check the policy page on the reservation website for details. Additional campground amenities information is available at the website.
