This notice announces an application submitted for a Department of the Army (DA) Permit, subject to Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899:

APPLICANT: Hilltop Basic Resources, Incorporated

Hilltop Big Bend Quarry 1 West 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 1100

LOCATION: On the left bank of the Ohio River at Mile 660;

at 1994 Paradise Bottom Road in Battletown, Meade

County, Kentucky 40104

Latitude: 38.1573 Longitude: -86.2977

7.5 Minute Ouad: IN-Leavenworth

PURPOSE: To reconfigure the fleeting arrangements for 47

barges with the installation of 5 additional dolphins along newly acquired 600 linear feet of riverfront property at the upstream end of the

existing barge terminal facility.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: This existing barge loading terminal has acquired 600 linear feet of additional property at its upstream end. Five additional dolphins would be installed to expand terminal operations and improve operational safety and efficiency. One dolphin would be placed at the midpoint of the existing configuration and four additional dolphins would be added to the upstream end of the property. Empty barges would be secured to the upstream dolphins, rather than utilizing the existing deadmen on the downstream end. The additional dolphin at the midpoint shown on Sheet 3 of 6 would allow safer and more secure staging of loaded barges.

The fleeting arrangement would be shifted upriver approximately 600 linear feet in front of the newly acquired property. The total number of barges present at one time would remain at 47, and would be configured as shown on Sheet 1 of 6 of the attached plans. The fleeting arrangement shown on Sheet 2 of 6 for the west (downstream)

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end of the facility depicts the maximum number of barges for that location in the event some of the 47 barges need to be moved to that end during staging. The maximum riverward projection for this facility at normal pool would be 192 feet.

REVIEW PROCEDURES: A DA Permit cannot be issued if any legally required Federal, State, or local authorization or certification is denied.

Copies of this notice are sent to the appropriate Federal and State Fish and Wildlife Agencies. Their views and comments are solicited in accordance with the Fish and Wildlife Coordination Act of 1956. Based on available information, the proposed activity will not destroy or endanger any Federally-listed threatened or endangered species or their critical habitats, as identified under the Endangered Species Act, and therefore, initiation of formal consultation procedures with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service is not planned at this time.

Any person may request, in writing, within the comment period specified in this notice, that a public hearing be held to consider this application. A request for a public hearing must state the specific interest which might be damaged by issuance of the DA Permit.

The National Register of Historic Places has been examined, and it has been determined that there are no properties currently listed on the Register which would be directly affected by the proposed work. If we are made aware, as a result of comments received in response to this notice, or by other means, of specific archaeological, scientific, prehistoric, or historical sites or structures which might be affected by the proposed work, the District Engineer will immediately take the appropriate action necessary pursuant to the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 - Public Law 89-665 as amended (including Public Law 96-515).

The decision whether to issue a permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impact of the proposed activity on the public interest. That decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The benefits which reasonably may be expected to accrue from the proposal must be balanced against its reasonably foreseeable detriments. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered; among those are conservation, economics, aesthetic values, general environmental concerns, historic values, fish and wildlife values, flood damage prevention, land use, navigation, recreation, water supply, water quality, energy needs, safety, food production, and in general, the needs and welfare of the public

The Corps of Engineers is soliciting comments from the public; Federal, State, and local agencies and officials; Indian tribes; and

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other interested parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of this proposed activity. It is presumed that all interested parties and agencies will wish to respond; therefore, a lack of response will be interpreted as meaning that there is no objection to the proposed project. Any comments received will be considered by the Corps of Engineers to determine whether to issue, modify, condition or deny a permit for this proposal. To make this decision, comments are used to assess impacts on endangered species, historic properties, water quality, general environmental effects, and the other public interest factors listed above. Comments are used in the preparation of an Environmental Assessment and/or an Environmental Impact Statement pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act. Comments are also used to determine the need for a public hearing and to determine the overall public interest of the proposed activity.

Written statements received in this office on or before the closing date will become a part of the official record and will be considered in the determination on this permit request. Any objections which are received during this period will be forwarded to the applicant for possible resolution before the determination is made whether to issue or deny the requested DA Permit. A permit will be granted unless its issuance is found to be contrary to the public interest.

All barges will be secured as shown by either dolphins, cell or by 1 1/2 " cables attached to deadmen as shown. 2" lock lines will be used as stern lines off of deadmen as shown

Up to 47 barges may be in harbor at one time not including the crane barge, coal barge or work barge. They may be at various positions depending on how many are loaded, empty or are in assembly. THE CRANE BARGE, COAL BARGE, WORK BARGE AND 47 BARGES AS SHOWN ARE CURRENTLY PERMITTED LRL-2008-950-pjl.
