Notice of Availability of Environmental Assessment

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Louisville District (District) announces the availability of the *Detailed Project Report and Integrated Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Section 14 Emergency Streambank Protection Project on White Lick Creek at Avon, Indiana*.

The EA compared potential effects to the quality of the environment from implementation of seven alternatives to address streambank erosion along White Lick Creek to protect public infrastructure, including County Road 625 East. The District is recommending a plan that includes the installation of launched soil nails with a riprap toe section of the slope on approximately 491 linear feet of streambank.

The District has determined that allowing the recommended plan to be implemented would not constitute a major federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment within the meaning of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969, as amended, and therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required.
