Notice of Availability of Environmental Assessment

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Louisville District (District) announces the availability of the *Draft Finding of No Significant Impact and Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Operations and Maintenance Action to Replace the Aging Waste Water Treatment Plant* at the William H. Harsha Flood Risk Management Project (Harsha Lake) in Batavia, Ohio.

The EA evaluate the potential effects to the quality of the environment from implementation of a project to replace the aging centralized wastewater treatment plant for areas served by the Operations area of Harsha Lake. The District is recommending a plan that includes the installation of a septic tank and mound system with a lateral discharge that will replace the existing obsolete waste water treatment facility that is being decommissioned. It is located on a tract adjacent to the existing facility.

The District has determined that allowing the preferred alternative to be implemented would not constitute a major federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment within the meaning of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969, as amended, and therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required.
