Former Grosse Ile Naval Air Station, a Formerly Used Defense Site

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Louisville District is seeking your input on establishing a formal Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) for the former Grosse Ile Naval Air Station, a Formerly Used Defense Site (FUDS).

Previous RAB assessments have yielded insufficient community interest in establishing a Restoration Advisory Board. Typically, at least 50 people are needed to show evidence of sufficient, sustained community interest to establish a RAB. If there isn't enough interest for a formal RAB, the USACE Louisville District will keep residents informed via other outreach methods such as newsletters and informational meetings.
