

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Proposed Plan
for the
Fuel Storage Area and Underground Storage Tank 10 Sites
Former Kincheloe Airforce Base
Kincheloe, Michigan

Public Meeting: March 23, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.
Comment Period: March 9 to April 10, 2020

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) recently issued a no further action proposed plan for the Fuel Storage Area and Underground Storage Tank 10 sites at the former Kincheloe Air Force Base, in Kincheloe, Michigan.

The findings and conclusion in the 2019 Final Revised Remedial Investigation Report demonstrate that contaminants of potential concern at the Fuel Storage Area and Underground Storage Tank 10 sites are below screening levels, indicating no further remedial action is necessary to protect human health or the environment.

USACE officials will make a formal presentation and accept written and oral comments at a public meeting at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, March 23, 2020 at Kinross Township Hall, 4884 W. Curtis Street, Kincheloe, Michigan. USACE will make its plan final after reviewing all comments received during the public comment period. The no further action proposed plan may be modified based on new information and/or public comments.
