

Why we need YOU



- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Great Lakes and Ohio River Division (LRD), Louisville District (LRL), plans to award new AE IDIQ contracts in 2023 for roofing centric designers.
- The proposed services, which will be obtained by negotiated Firm Fixed Price Contracts, are for a variety of Architect/Engineer services primarily for Roofing and Building Envelope repair and replacement for the Army Reserve projects nationwide (including U.S. Territories)
- These contracts will provide for designers for building envelope and roof replacement requirements under North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code 541330.
- Selection criteria are expected to include experience design 20 year NDL roofs for single ply, mod bit, and steep slope systems. Selection criteria are also expected to include requirements for firms with multiple RRCs and registered Architects or Engineers on staff.

Doing Business with the Government



Step 1: Identify your NAICS code(s) (This contract NAICS is 541330)

Step 2: Obtain a DUNS Number from Dun & Bradstreet

Step 3: Register in the System for Award Management (SAM) (www.sam.gov)

Step 4: Determine if your firm qualifies for 8(a), SDB, WOSB, SDVOSB, or HUBZone certification

Step 5: Begin to search for federal government procurement opportunities



How to Obtain the Solicitation



- Requirements to download Technical Data Package
 - 1) Need to be registered in System for Award Management (SAM) (www.sam.gov)

 Pre-Solicitation Notice – scheduled to be posted to FBO in November 2022

Advertisement – minimum 30 days to prepare proposals



How to Obtain the Solicitation



- Contract Opportunities at <u>www.sam.gov</u>
- View interested vendors list and register as an interested vendor

- Register to receive notifications and updates/amendments
- RFP technical information will be posted on the sam.gov website along with any amendments



The Procurement Process



- Two-Phase Design-Build (D-B) Request for Proposals (RFP)
- IDIQ is a projected to be Small Business Set-Aside with up to 5 Awards
- Each contract with capacity of \$9 M
- Project award will be made on most qualified basis as described in the evaluation criteria
- Proposals must be submitted on time. The Louisville District is in the Eastern time zone.
- The Source Selection Evaluation Board (SSEB) evaluates contractors' proposals based on specific factors which are defined in the RFP Package. Read the RFP requirements.



Evaluation of Proposals



- Factors will be rated in the identified order of importance
- Projects Submitted for Past Performance will utilize a Relevancy Rating
 - Very Relevant, Relevant, Somewhat Relevant, Not Relevant
- All Past Performance information is evaluated and assigned a final overall Performance Confidence Rating
 - Substantial Confidence, Satisfactory Confidence, Neutral Confidence, Limited Confidence, and No Confidence
- All technical factors will utilize Adjectival Ratings
 - Outstanding, Good, Acceptable, Marginal, and Unacceptable

- Contracting opportunities are posted in the Federal Business Opportunity (FBO) website at www.sam.gov. Use "W912QR" to search for Louisville District projects.
- Actively Respond to Sources Sought Notices (Market Surveys) posted to FBO
- Actively Respond to Competitive Requirements posted to FBO (limited number of sole source opportunities)
