The wetland appears to receive hydrology from surface water runoff and a seasonal high water table. There are no streams or other aquatic features near the wetland or site. The closest potential (a)(2) tributary is over 1,000 ft southwest of the site. The wetland does not meet the definition of adjacent wetlands per 33 CFR 328.3 (c)(1)(i)(ii)(iii) or (iv), and is therefore excluded per 33 CFR 328.3 (b)(1) as a non-adjacent wetland.
