Dear Mr. Buskirk:

This is in reference to Department of the Army (DA) Permit Number LRL-2010-39 which authorized the placement of dredged or fill material into "waters of the United States" for the construction of six crossings of Section 3 of the Interstate 69 Evansville to Indianapolis extension.

In a letter dated September 7, 2010, you were informed that the subject DA permit had been suspended in accordance with 33 CFR 325.7(c) because a review of the file revealed that the procedural requirements of 33 CFR 327.4 regarding public hearings were not complied with prior to issuance of the permit.

The procedural requirements have now been complied with and in accordance with 33 CFR 325.7, I have decided to reinstate DA Permit Number LRL-2010-39. The ENG Form 1721 executed on July 14, 2010, remains valid.

Should any modification of the plans become necessary for any reason, approval from the District Engineer must be received prior to the start of the work.
